Psychiatry: Fascinating and Rewarding Career Choice

Over 54 million Americans are estimated to have a mental disorder, of which 8 million seek treatment. The number of children that have a mental disorder is projected to be between 7 to 13 million in the United States. These patients are served by specially trained physicians known as psychiatrists. Psychiatrists are physicians that specialize in the evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of patients with mental conditions. There are a variety of conditions that a psychiatrist can treat, including but not limited to; post traumatic stress disorder, bipolar disorder, personality disorders, eating disorders, major depressive disorders, obsessive compulsive disorder, panic, schizophrenia, and substance abuse.

A psychiatrist can treat either adults or children, depending on their level of specialization. Patients can be evaluated on an individual basis, with the patient's family, and/or in a restricted group setting. Depending on each individual patient's condition, the psychiatrist may determine that medication is the best alternative for treatment. Most psychiatrists are involved with research regarding issues on mental disorders.

But what does it take to be a psychiatrist? The minimum educational requirement for entry into a medical school is three years of college, but most applicants have at least a bachelor's degree. There are 146 medical schools in the United States, and they require applicants to submit school transcripts, scores from the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) and letters of recommendation. Students spend most of the first two years of medical school in laboratories and classrooms, and the last two years working with patients in hospitals and clinics under the supervision of experienced physicians. They gain experience in several areas through rotations or by spending concentrated time in specialties such as internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatrics, psychiatry and surgery.

Following four years of medical school and, psychiatrists enter a medical residency program that lasts four years during which the resident is working at the hospital or clinic seeing patients under the watchful eye of supervising physicians.

There are 182 accredited psychiatry residency programs in the United States.

Nationally there are approximately 4,522 active psychiatry residents. Approximately 51 percent of the psychiatry residents nationally are female and 49 percent are male.

The University of Cincinnati offers a four-year accredited program for psychiatry. Residents and interns are paid and provided benefits. The pay ranges from \$41,000 to \$46,000, depending on their year of training. There are eight psychiatry residency slots each year at the University of Cincinnati.
