Internal Medicine: Fascinating and Rewarding Career Choice

Millions of people in the United States are affected by a medical condition that an internist can diagnose and treat. A doctor of internal medicine, or internist, is a physician that is specially trained in conditions regarding; General medicine, cancer, infectious disease, the respiratory system, the vascular system, the endocrine system/hormones, digestion, heart, blood, kidneys, urinary tract, neurological disorders, allergies, and rheumatology.

Internists have a variety of training with different conditions, so they will be able to assess a patient's diagnostic problem, which could involve a variety of illnesses or chronic disease. Since internists generally see only adult patients, it is likely that a person may have several conditions relating to a particular disease. If a condition is severe, the internist may refer the patient to another specialist.

In addition to the treatment of disease, internists also promote health and wellness by teaching their patients about disease prevention. An internist will educate patients on women's health, substance abuse, mental health, as well as valuable tips on the treatment of common health problems.

But what does it take to be an internist? The minimum educational requirement for entry into a medical school is three years of college, but most applicants have at least a bachelor's degree. There are 146 medical schools in the United States, and they require applicants to submit school transcripts, scores from the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) and letters of recommendation. Students spend most of the first two years of medical school in laboratories and classrooms, and the last two years working with patients in hospitals and clinics under the supervision of experienced physicians. They gain experience in several areas through rotations or by spending concentrated time in specialties such as internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatrics, psychiatry and surgery.

Following four years of medical school and one year as an intern, internists enter a medical residency program that lasts three years during which the resident is working at the hospital or clinic seeing patients under the watchful eye of supervising physicians. There are 388 accredited internal medicine residency programs in the United States.

Nationally there are approximately 21,351 active internal medicine residents. Approximately 59 percent of the internal medicine residents nationally are male and 41 percent are female.

The University of Cincinnati offers a three-year accredited program for internal medicine, as well as an optional fourth year for those interested in a combined program for internal medicine and pediatrics. Residents and interns are paid and provided benefits. The pay ranges from \$41,000 to \$46,000, depending on their year of training. There are fifteen to eighteen internal medicine residency slots each year at the University of Cincinnati, and six to twelve slots each year at Good Samaritan Hospital.
